Cruising Gear

This vessel includes numerous items for long distance adventure cruising. These include:

- **Self-Steering.** Aries self-steering wind vane is available and included in the sales price. It is stowed in the cockpit lazarette with fans in the V berth.
- **Solar Panels.** Solar panels are mounted on the cockpit railings and can be adjusted to maximize efficiency given the vessels tack and position to the sun.
- **Life raft.** The Viking Life raft is included in the sale of the vessel. The new owner will want to have the unit serviced before they begin cruising and require a life raft.
- **Water maker.** The operational status of the water-maker is currently unknown, but is believed to be serviceable. For pricing purposes, no further adjustment for the water-maker will be made at time of survey. In short, the water maker unit is sold "as is".
