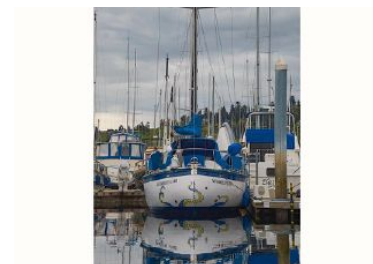

What a great strong seriously good sailing boat! If you are looking for a reasonable priced comfortable, offshore capable boat, please check out this rare Bruce Roberts 341. Like most of Bruce Roberts designs, this 34' boat has massive storage, and a slippery, strong solid-core hull, with glassed solid deck. The combination of the double-ender design and protected cockpit, reduces worry about following seas. The huge interior is surprising light with many opening port-lights and feels more like a 40 footer! 6,300 lbs of ballast in a 34' hull, makes for a seriously stiff, stable safe boat, with a nice smooth roll motion.

You may know Doug Lombard the owner, sailing instructor, and founder of the Coho Ho Ho Rally. He's added the bow sprit, great opening NFM port-lights, electronics and sails, and many fine and salty touches. You know this is a serious sailing boat, with simple systems, and a strong Yanmar diesel.
