Ready for your own boat? Looking for your next boat and want to be sailing with friends? Have you looked at the boat show prices? This Catalina 28 just might be the easily affordable, comfortable Puget Sound cruiser to get you out there sailing. With simple manageable systems, and a comfortable large volume design, the Catalina 28 is a surprising boat. Somehow it just feels bigger, both inside and in the gracious cockpit. Like many of Gerry Douglas designs, every detail has been shaped for Catalina sailors. If you have sailed on any of his later designs like the 32-35, you will recognize the similarities, and thoughtful accommodations.

The Catalina 28 MK I is a fantastic, well loved cruising boat for a couple or small family. It has many features of larger boats yet is nimble and easy to maintain. The cockpit is spacious and comfortable with a cockpit cushions, a teak table and beverage holder. All sheets and halyards all run aft to the cockpit, control is simple and straightforward. The open transom and swim step make access to a dinghy or dock safe and convenient.

The main cabin is light and cozy with skylights and center-line table. There is a separate aft cabin with a double berth and comfortable V berth forward. The galley and head have hot and cold pressure water. The head is to port at foot of companion way with standard marine toilet, sink, and shower capabilities. The Catalina 28 is a popular design with over 620 models built, a good Catalina Association, and parts support.
