A downeast profile, quality construction and a beautiful teak interior characterize the Saberline 34, a modern trawler-style sedan from Sabre Yachts. She's built on the same Modified-V hull used in production of the original Sabreline 36 with moderate beam and a shallow keel for directional stability. Like all Sabre boats there's no shortage of craftsmanship or attention to detail in the way she's put together. The interior is arranged with the galley forward in the salon opposite the lower helm and an island double berth, that's easy to access from either side, in the forward stateroom. The island berth lifts for additional storage. There is also ample storage including a cedar-lined hanging locker and multiple drawers. Everything is carefully arranged with an eye toward practicality and comfort. The large salon windows all open so ventilation in this boat is exceptional. Notable features include excellent engine access, stall shower in the head which also has a wet locker.
