Description

One World, a 2007 Fountaine Pajot Mahé 36 is a versatile, comfortable catamaran with an excellent balance of performance and comfort. It's rare to find a cruising catamaran in this size, as most are built in the 40-50 foot range for charters. Designed by Joubert-Nivelt with interior design by Flahault Design & Associates, the 11 meter Mahé 36 model was built by Fountaine Pajot starting in 2004. More than 1400 Cruising Catamarans have been built by Fountaine Pajot - more than any other multihull yard.

One World is equipped with the usual modern amenities - a light, bright salon with an aft-facing galley, spacious cockpit, and a bimini for cockpit shade, and rain protection. Each hull provides a double berth aft, storage, with the spacious head forward. The salon table can be lowered as needed for additional sleepers. This design keeps the catamaran bows light for better performance. The Mahé 36 is known for its excellent sailing performance, featuring a hi-roach mainsail, which increases sail area aloft. Sail Area is 700 ft² + Spinnaker and Bridge Clearance is 55' + Antenna. Of course, there is a stackpack on the boom for easy handling. Twin solid hulls without daggerboards make for a quieter evening when anchored. Draft is 3.5' so you can anchor closer to shore. A secure anchor system with heavy Vulcan anchor and Lofrans Cayman Electric Windlass deploys from a forward deck locker. Note the larger Volvo Volvo D1-30 Diesel Engines, for a cruise speed of 6.5kt @2000rpm @ 1/2gph per engine.
